**VOTER REGISTRATION-EDUCATION:  
ADDED COMPONENT TO CARVER FESTIVAL**

*The April 30<sup>th</sup> scheduled Carver Festival will offer more than the traditional festivities of Parade, Car Show, Vendors, Science Fair, and Stage Entertainment. With 2016 as a very active “Political Decision Year,” voter registration and education will be available to all attendees, especially citizens seeking to become eligible voters.*

*Coordinated by Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.-Beta Xi Omega Chapter, an official request has been made for the Voter-ID-Mobile-Unit to be stationed on the Downtown Square in Tuskegee throughout the Carver Festival’s eventful day. Citizens who need ID for voting eligibility can meet this requirement during the Festival. Requests have also been delivered for an Attorney, Judge, or Probation Officer to be on site for the purpose of providing citizens with information regarding the process of restoring their voting rights. In addition, any 17 year olds who will be 18 on or before Election Day, may also register to vote. In essence, not one eligible citizen should be left behind or miss the August 23<sup>rd</sup> City of Tuskegee Elections and the November 8<sup>th</sup> Presidential Election.*
