A Resolution implementing the 2017 Severe Weather Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday Feb. 24-26, 2017

WHEREAS, the 2017 Severe Weather Sales Tax Holiday begins at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, February 24, 2017 and ends at twelve midnight on Sunday, February 26, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Sales Tax Holiday Rule requires a participating county or municipality to submit a certified copy of their adopted resolution or ordinance providing for the Sales Tax Holiday, and any subsequent amendments thereof, to the Alabama Department of Revenue before January 24, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Department of Revenue will compile a list of counties and municipalities participating in the Sales Tax Holiday and issue a current publication on its website.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tuskegee, Alabama as follows:

1. That the City of Tuskegee intends to participate in the 2017 Sales Tax Holiday.
2. That the City Manager submits the necessary form and a certified copy of this resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue.
