3. That **Ala Whitehead** received a majority of the votes cast for the Office of **Council Member, District 2** and is hereby declared elected to that Office for a term beginning on the first Monday in November (November 7) 2016.
4. That **Shirley W. Curry** received a majority of the votes cast for the Office of **Council Member, District 3** and is hereby declared elected to that Office for a term beginning on the first Monday in November (November 7) 2016.
5. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the Office of Council Member-at-Large and that **Annie Lucas Brown** and **Jacqueline D. Gullette** received the most and second most votes for that office; therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 4, 2016, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-55, Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended.
