A. Ordinance No. 2020-02. Establishing Salaries for Mayor/Council (RE: Aug 2020 Election). (adopt)

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02 (Adopted) An Ordinance Establishing the Salaries of the Mayor and Council Members for the City of Tuskegee, Alabama regarding the 2020 Municipal Election

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUSKEGEE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** That the salary of the Mayor of the City of Tuskegee, Alabama shall be the same hereby fixed at \$28,000.00 annually to be paid in twenty-six (26) equal installments, bi-weekly.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the Councilmember-at-Large shall be compensated at the sum of \$11,700.00 annually to be paid in twenty-six (26) equal installments, bi-weekly.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That each councilmember shall be compensated at the sum of \$11,000.00 annually to be paid in twenty-six (26) equal installments, bi-weekly.
- **Section 4.** That the members of the City Council shall be entitled to participation in the insurance programs provided by the City of Tuskegee under the same terms as City employees.
- <u>Section 5.</u> That this ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in November, 2020 and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the Council.
- **Section 6.** The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; if any portion of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
