1. That in the interest of compliance with FAA rules, regulations, restrictions, and appropriate standards for airports receiving FAA funding in addition to local public safety and operational management necessities of the Tuskegee Municipal Airport aka Moton Field; it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Tuskegee that a complete review of all policies, regulations, operations and management procedures related to the activity of skydiving, soaring, ultralights, banner towing, sports parachuting and other like aeronautical activities presently occurring at the City Airport are hereby

Ordered to immediately cease on a temporary basis at the Tuskegee Municipal Airport aka Moton Field pending a full review of all policies, procedures, operations and regulations pertaining to these activities.

- 2. That the City Manager or his designee shall notify in writing all persons and entities who currently operate such activities at the Tuskegee Municipal Airport aka Moton Field of this action by the City Council of the City of Tuskegee,
- 3. The City Manager and the City Attorney are instructed and directed to consult with the Federal Aeronautical Administration and all other appropriate agencies and officials on the Federal and State levels in regard to the law, duties and responsibilities of the City of Tuskegee in relation to these activities at the Tuskegee Municipal Airport aka Moton Field.
- 4. The City Manager and City Attorney are requested to brief the City Council on their progress in this regard within ninety (90) days of the date of this Resolution.
